RESOLUTION 2023-1101

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE UPPER VERDE RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTATARIES.

WHEREAS, The Upper Verde River and its tributaries, located between the Verde headwaters and the Town of Clarkdale in central Arizona in the Prescott and Coconino National Forests, is an important and unique public resource that provides numerous benefits to the human and natural communities; and

WHEREAS, Central Arizona is one of the most rapidly growing areas in the United States, and increasing urbanization pressures threaten the natural wild character and environment that makes the area special and valuable; and

WHEREAS, the protection of The Upper Verde River and its tributaries as a National Wild and Scenic River will help to protect and restore the Yavapai Apache Nation's ancestral lands and cultural history in the watershed. Additionally, this will expand recreational opportunities for camping, birding, boating, fishing, horseback riding, hiking and other recreational activities.

WHEREAS, Fish experts agree The Upper Verde River and its tributaries are one of the best native fish refuges in the Southwest.

WHEREAS, Arizona tourism contributes tens of billions of dollars a year to the State's economy, with wildlife viewing and associated activities contributing billions of dollars annually and creating numerous jobs in Arizona; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde hereby requests the United States Congress pass legislation to designate the Upper Verde and its critical tributaries as a "Wild and Scenic River" this year in order to permanently protect this unique special place for present and future generations. Copies of this resolution shall be sent to the United States Arizona Congressional Legislators and select key Legislators at the appropriate time.
